

Guidelines for poster:

Must include:

- 1. Title
- 2. Objectives/Summary
- 3. Mini-bio (email address, phone number, affiliation/association, photo)
- 4. Acknowledgements/References (students, staff, etc.)
- 5. Images (make it presentable!)

**Submit brief topic summary (100-200 words) and poster outline by <u>January</u> <u>4th</u>, <u>2019</u> to be entered into the competition.

- Make sure that your advisor/supervisor/co-authors sign off on your abstract before submission; all submitted abstracts will become public information, so it is your responsibility to make sure that there are no confidential issues.
- Only the top 10 poster topics will be chosen to be presented at the conference. Selected poster contest participants will receive a complimentary student conference registration.
- Students must provide their own poster supplies/printing – Posters should be foam core board (approx. 48"x36")

Topical Areas:

As a part of the submission process, you are asked to pick a topic from the 10 following research areas:

- 1. Environmental Compliance
- 2. STEM Education
- 3. Sustainability
- 4. Chemical Engineering
- 5. Environmental Engineering
- 6. Resource Management
- 7. Environmental Law/Policy
- 8. Geology/Hydrogeology
- 9. Fuels, Petrochemicals, and Alternative Energy Sources
- 10. Other (Environmental Science Topics)
