Once approval is granted, stakeholder input will then be open for feedback.



- Transporters


#### Hazardous Waste Universe





#### LQG Universe






## LQG Manufacturing Universe






#### Manufacturing Violations LQG Universe








(or in other hazardous waste accumulation areas where the hazards are present)























### **TIPS for Compliance Storage**

- Keep a container tracking log
- Check dates on containers during weekly inspections
- Ship at least every 90 days (LQG) or 180 days (SQG)










# Name three (3) requirements for storage of universal waste lamps.
