All entries must include:

- Title
- Objectives/Summary
- Mini-Bio contact info, school, degree program, and photo
- References Make sure that your advisor/supervisor/co-authors sign off on your topic summary before submission
- · Images make it presentable!

Please Note:

- Posters must demonstrate <u>original</u> <u>research</u> with the potential for <u>practical application</u> in the environmental industry.
- All entries must comply with the <u>academic integrity standards</u> held by the participant's school and department.
- The use of <u>artificial intelligence (AI)</u> is strictly prohibited.

Important Dates:

- Topic summaries (100-200 words) must be submitted by December 15, 2025.
- Only 8 topic summaries will be chosen for the competition.
 Students will be notified of top 8 selection by <u>December 29, 2025</u>.
- Free printing will be provided for posters that are electronically submitted to the Operations Manager (contact below) by January 30, 2026.
- After the deadline, students will be required to print their own posters on <u>foam core board</u> (approx. 36"x48").
