

EPAZ Conference Abstract Submittal Guidelines 2026

Guidelines

- Abstract should be single spaced, one paragraph between 150 to 250 words, submitted in 12 font Times New Roman submitted as an MS word (.doc or .docx) or PDF.
- Abstracts that are general descriptions of a new product or commercial or that read like advertisements may be rejected. The purpose of the presentation is educational/technical and sales presentations will be discouraged.
- Limit the length of the title to no more than 10 words or 100 characters.
- Explicit description of the topic describing the results or outcomes of the work with implications or contributions to the environment.
- Proofread very carefully for formatting, spelling, and grammar to avoid errors before submission.
- Tables and images are not acceptable for this submission.
- Do not cite references in the abstract.
- Please spell out all abbreviations and acronyms.
- All authors and presenters must be listed at the time of submission. If not, we cannot guarantee that print materials will be accurate.
- Please plan your presentation to be 25-30 minutes in length. The programing will allow 5-10 additional minutes for Q&A. Please plan to have at least 2 questions that the moderator can ask you just in case there are no questions from the audience.
- You will be notified by January 5th, 2026 (at the latest) if the abstract is selected for the Conference.
